



Call for Workshops

What are we looking for?

We are looking for inspiring, interactive and interesting workshops that touch upon the topic of the conference: **What is history for? History and the present world.**

The workshops should:

- Last <u>maximum 90 minutes</u>, including the time for Q&A and, by choice the collection of evaluation on the workshop;
- Involve participants to the workshop with an interactive element;
- Be hosted in **English**;
- Touch upon the topic of the conference or one of the following subtopics:
 - History as a tool to promote diversity;
 - History as a tool to reflect on the present;
 - History as a tool to encourage the development of competences for democratic culture;

What do we offer?

If you are selected to host a workshop at the 28th EuroClio Annual Conference, <u>EUROCLIO will</u> cover your participation fee for one day of conference (the day of the workshop), amounting to 90 <u>EUR</u>. <u>IMPORTANT!</u> This discount is valid only if you are not eligible for any other discount. Accommodation and travel to the conference will not be covered.

Selection process and criteria

The deadline for applying for a workshop is 15.01.2022. We will be selecting at least 7 workshops.

EuroClio will review the applications and select the workshops for the 28th Annual Conference by February 10th. Applicants will then be contacted and will receive information on how to proceed for the registration to the conference¹. Any delay in the selection will be communicated via email to all applicants.

<u>Selection will be based on motivation, experience, geographical balance, gender balance, and ability to contribute to the Conference programme with innovative and inspiring content.</u>
